**Trolley for loading
and transport of kayaks**

INSTRUCTIONS

NOTE! First read the User Manual and Safety Instructions. Before use, check that TROLLER is intact and does not have any damage to wheels and feet. The feet on the longer legs are adjustable (th-readed out) if needed for car models with narrower rear so the wheel turns freely.



TROLLER's short legs should always face forward, in the direction of travel.

FORWARD

KAYAK TRANSPORTATION:



1. Place TROLLER beside the kayak pointing towards the stern of the kayak with the shorter legs upwards and forwards.
2. Place the kayak on TROLLER in the direction of travel. With a little push forward the kayak falls into place.
3. Secure kayak with a strap or similar through the TROLLER loops.

LOADING ON TO CAR ROOFS:



4. Fasten a strap around the roof rack. Tip: Adjust your strap according to your car so it's ready to hold TROLLER in the correct position.
5. Place TROLLER with the short legs on the car roof in line with the kayak supports/placement.
6. Attach the strap around the hook.

NOTE! Max weight/load: 80 kg. Check that the meeting surfaces are clean, if necessary, place a towel or similar between TROLLER and on the car.



7. Place the rear of the kayak in line with the intended position on the car roof and the front near to the car's rear wheel.

8. Place the front of the kayak on TROLLER.

9. Take a firm grip on the rear and slowly roll up the kayak up onto the roof rack. Please note that the kayak is rolled in the same direction as the wheels.

10. Move it slowly into correct position.

UNLOADING:



11. Place TROLLER on the car, see fig. 4–6. Pull the kayak backwards. Tip: An extension strap attached in e.g. the rear handle of the kayak can be of good help.

12. When the kayak reaches the wheels of TROLLER, grip firmly and slowly move the kayak towards the ground.

13. Place the rear of the kayak on the ground, making sure it does not slide backwards. **NOTE!** Do not pull too far as it may fall off!



TROLLER – a shortcut to "the moment"
